

**FROG POND LAKE WATER CONTROL AND
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO.1**

**Minutes of Meeting
September 19, 2026**

BOARD OF DIRECTORS PRESENT:

The Board of Directors of FPLWCID No.1 held a meeting on September 19, 2026, at the Colmesneil Community Center at 300 Hwy 256, Colmesneil, TX 75938.

Opened the meeting with the 2026 tax hearing. The hearing was called to order at 10:30 A.M. Two Residents are present, Public comment: None. No questions were raised, and the hearing was closed.

The regular meeting was called to order at 10:34 A.M. The Board reviewed the meeting minutes from August 15, 2025. A Motion was made to accept the meeting minute; motion was seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Next, the adoption of the FPLWCID tax rate for 2027. Motion was made to approve the tax rate at 0.32.3% for 2027. Motion was made to accept; motion was seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Next, the treasurer reported bank balance to date of this meeting is \$ 23,479.60. A Motion was made to accept the treasure report; motion was seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Next, Discussion and action to set the 2027 meeting dates. The dates selected are January 16, April 10, August 14, and September 18. Motion was made to accept; motion was seconded; motion carried unanimously.

Next, Discussion and action regarding repair or replacing the weir gate. Not much movement on this agenda item. Lochow was contacted and they declined to quote to perform the work on the weir. The board also discussed reaching out to other companies to get a quote for the welding and fabrication of the weir gate. This item is active/ongoing.

Next, Discussion and action regarding the weed growth in the lake. Lochow was contacted and they offered a quote in the \$30k range to treat all the west end lake area. No other details offered. The board also discussed the use of the sterile grass carp and fish barriers on the spillway needed during high water events. Lochow also offered the supply of carp at rate of \$23.50 per fish. The TPWD application fee for carp is \$2.00 per fish. Stan Evens stated he will contact the Texas Parks and Wildlife to find what is best solution for Lake Frog Pond if carp is our best option.

Next was the discussion and possible action on matters related to the Dam and spraying the Westend. The county commissioner was contacted about mowing the dam. The county came out and mowed the dam at the end of August. The board also discussed spraying the weeds on the backside of the spillway. The board will order the chemicals to spray and the back of the spillway will be sprayed when the weather allows.

Next, Discussion and possible action on mowing / spraying the dam. The dam was mowed in August and sprayed on 9/5/26.

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Next, Discussion and possible action on matters and status related to the dam. No new comments were discussed.

Next is public comments. Paul Dans and Eyleen Bergold made comments concerning the lake vegetation and weed control. Also Eyleen commented on the collaboration between the FPPOA and FPLWCID concerning the weed removal that was done and the spraying of the west end since these two activities happened at different times.

Next motion was made to adjourn, motion was seconded, meeting was adjourned at 11:12 am.
